



Pilgrim Code of Conduct

As a member of the archdiocesan delegation to World Youth Day, I acknowledge that I am an ambassador of my parish and the Archdiocese of New York. The delegation depends on the cooperation of all pilgrims to help serve as a network of support. I will show respect for God, others and places at all times and behave responsibly and participate actively in the events. I also agree to:

- Speak and behave in a way that exemplifies Christian values.
- Limit physical contact with others to what is appropriate for the situation and to what is unambiguously non-sexual and does not cause discomfort or stress to the recipient and/others.
- Dress modestly.
- Refrain from drug use or alcohol abuse. If consuming alcohol I will exercise prudence when appropriate for a spiritual pilgrimage; possession of drugs (except medication) and poor behavior from intoxication will not be tolerated.
- I will follow US drinking laws and will not drink alcohol if under 21. If I am over 21, I will not consume alcohol in front of pilgrims under age 21.
- Comply with the directives from my Group Leader.
- Inform your Group Leaders (or Delegation Leader) if leaving the group, and will travel with at least one other person where ever I go.
- I will report any behavior or situations I may find concerning to my Group or Delegation Leader.
- Sleep in rooms as assigned by Group or Delegation Leaders and remain in my assigned room after curfew on each night of the pilgrimage.
- Cover my expenses for alternate travel plans should I be asked by the Group Leader to leave the delegation.

I understand that any disregard for the above will result in discipline or removal from the delegation.
